All Saints Day- Through the years the First of November has been noted as all saints day. It is the day when Christians have remembered their fellowship with the saints and martyrs, with all those believers who now in spirit stand before the throne of the Lamb. We thank our Lord for their witness and example and we are comforted by the fact that they are not lost but safe with Jesus. Sadly, false teaching and superstition has arisen and some now pray to the saints or ask the intercession of those who have died. Scripture tells us that all our prayers are to be addressed to our Lord and that Christ is our only intercessor.

Passages that Speak of Snow- The Bible has several passages that mention snow. Here are a few of them:
